Campus Security Tips Some principles for strengthening student's awareness of safety and preventing harm and enhancing student's emergency skills while encountering dangers are as follows:

(1) TRY TO GO IN COMPANY WITH SOMEONE WHEN POSSIBLE. NEVER GO THROUGH DARK ALLEYS, LESS CROWDED AREAS, OR DANGEROUS LOCATIONS.

(2) Avoid staying alone in the classroom during leisure time, or going to the remote corners of the campus, or going to a restroom alone to ensure your own safety.

(3) IF YOU HAPPEN TO MEET SUSPICIOUS STRANGERS IN CAMPUS, NOTIFY SCHOOL STAFFS IMMEDIATELY

(4) When strangers ask for directions, you may help them with kindness, whereas no need to guide them in person. Don't leave your school under the strangers' guidance.

(5) IN CASE OF BEING FOLLOWED BY STRANGERS OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL, RUN QUICKLY TO A PEOPLE- CROWDED PLACES OR NEARBY CONVENIENCE STORES. AND YELL LOUDLY TO ATTRACT OTHER PEOPLE'S ATTENTION AND SEEK AIDS
